MR ANTOINE OLLIVIER RE-ELECTED DEPUTY REGISTRAR OF THE TRIBUNAL

Today, Mr Antoine Ollivier was re-elected Deputy Registrar by the judges of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea.



Mr Ollivier, a French national, has been Deputy Registrar of the Tribunal since 2020. He previously worked at the International Court of Justice, where he served as a Legal Officer and also Special Assistant to the Registrar, as well as at the Directorate for Legal Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of France. Mr Ollivier has authored several articles and chapters on public international law. His full biography is available on the website of the Tribunal.

Pursuant to the Rules of the Tribunal, the Deputy Registrar of the Tribunal is elected from among candidates nominated by the judges of the Tribunal. The Deputy Registrar, whose functions are defined by article 37 of the Rules of the Tribunal, assists the Registrar and acts as Registrar in the latter's absence.
